BPD Interdisciplinary Team: Severe

Improving the clinical care of infants with severe chronic lung disease of prematurity



What is **BIT:S**?

A **multidisciplinary** team designed to:

- . Manage preterm babies with severe BPD
- . Improve clinical care
- . Improve patient outcomes

When Are BIT:S Rounds?

Which Patients Are Eligible?

PMA >36 weeks AND **any** of the following:

- Pulmonary hypertension . Mechanical ventilation
- NIPPV / CPAP
- . HFNC \geq 2L/min
- FiO2>30%

. **2 pm** on the **1st** and **3rd Tuesday** of each month . If the patient can't be seen at BIT:S rounds (after the initial consult), they will be seen when rounds are held again.

What's My Role?

GI

Anticipated discharge with G-tube or GJ tube

- Pts. on acid suppression therapy/
- considering a work-up for GER
- Feeding issues: poor feeding, feeding

NICU Attending & Primary Team

At 36 weeks PMA determine if patient meets eligibility criteria

Initiate BIT:S consult the day the infant meets eligibility criteria

Resident/Nurse Practitioner

Fellow

- refusal, dysphagia, possible referral to the feeding team
- Weight Z-score below -1.5 @ 36 weeks PMA / drop in Z-score > 0.8 from birth

ENT

- 36 wks PMA on any PP support
- Voice absent/weak/hoarse cry
- Noisy breathing and/or stridor
- Abnormal tracheobronchial tree by chest x-

Order in CERNER:

- NICU Interdisciplinary Team consult
- Arterial blood gas
- Airway Evaluation by ENT (if indicated)
- Intensivist consult (if indicated)
- Basic metabolic panel
- □ EKG

Secretary

- - Complete BIT:S consult form (at desk)
 - Hand completed form to secretary
 - Doc-to-Doc sign-out with Dr Daigle
 - Invite family to join BIT:S rounds and/or update family with recommendations and plans
 - Lead patient discussion on BIT:S rounds
 - Check criteria for pediatric intensivist
- Place BIT:S consult in front of patient chart
